Firstly, I must say the school looks fantastic! A big **thankyou** to all the volunteers who painted walls, cleaned windows and did lots of jobs to get our school ready for the new term. The kind volunteers were "marshalled" by **Mrs Sawyer** who spent a lot of her summer break working very hard- a thank you to her also!

And so welcome back and a warm welcome to our two new families!

We have had a very positive start to the new term. In assemblies and classes we have focused on the children setting themselves new **challenges and goals**. Please ask your child/ children what they are hoping to learn and do well this term. The children also have individual Writing Targets in the front of their Writing Books: please discuss these too!

At school we have adopted a new **Handwriting** approach which develops a clear, cursive, joined style from early in the school. The children will be encouraged to develop this over the term.

Homework continues to be an important way parents can support their children and the learning in school. As previously reading every night/ day is essential. Please talk to your child/ children about their book. Even very good readers will benefit from talking about characters, what might happen next, what was inferred.....

We are adopting a Menu approach to Homework- where classes send home a list of learning activities (some short and some longer) which must be completed at a rate of one a week over the course of the half term. These are to be returned on a Monday. Spellings work will be sent home on a Friday and returned on a Monday. There will not be a formal test on the Monday.

More details will be available from classes.

Dinner Money: The cost of a school meal each day has increased this year to £2.30. If your child is having a school meal and they are in KS2 (Years 3-6) the cost of meals this half term will be £78.20 (34 days @ £2.30). If you wish to pay weekly the cost is £11.50. A polite reminder that meals must be paid for in advance as we do not have the cash flow to manage debts in school.

Children in Foundation to Year 2 qualify for Universal Free School meals so there is no charge.
