POLITE REMINDERS

Parking along Apreece Road

We have had an issue raised regarding parking along Apreece Road, we would kindly ask for you to park with consideration for the residents.

Attendance — Schools are no longer permitted to authorise term time holidays. There may be times when a child needs to be out of school for exceptional circumstances. In each case this needs to be requested and will be considered on an individual basis. You will be notified whether your request for absence is unauthorised or not. Schools meet regularly with the Education Welfare Officer who will look at all cases of unauthorised absence. A decision may be made to refer to the county legal team for their consideration to issue a fine or not.

If your child is sick then please telephone the school office before 9.30am so we can ensure that they are marked on the register correctly.

Please ensure that your child arrives in school before the whistle at 8:50am as lateness can be upsetting for a child, particularly if their class has already settled learning. It is the duty of parents to ensure that children attend school regularly and punctually. This encourages habits of good timekeeping and lessens any possible classroom disruption. Just to remind you that the school gate opens at 8:40am and shuts at 8:50am, if your child arrives after this time and is signed in through the school office, this will result in a late mark being recorded

Please note that if your child arrives after registers close at 9:05, we are required to record this as an unauthorised absence
