Dear Parents/ Carers,

World Book Day 2024 takes place on <u>Thursday 7th March</u>. This year we would like to try and mix up the options for marking the day as we know not all children enjoy dressing up. Children may choose from one (or all) of the following options:

Dressing Up

The children can come into school as their **favourite character from a book** for the day. If children would prefer not to dress up then they should come in their usual school uniform.

Decorating a Potato

We are inviting the children to decorate a potato (or other vegetable) to reflect their favourite book or book character. These will be displayed in school on the day as part of our celebrations.

Creating a Piece of Artwork or Poster

Children could create a piece of artwork reflecting their favourite book or create a poster to advertise their favourite book to others. This will be displayed in school to encourage a love of reading. Please make sure that children name their art work!

£1 Book Token

All children will receive a World Book Day token which they will be bringing home today. World Book Day celebrates the joy and value of books and reading, especially for children. To help get them started on their reading journey, every child receives a £1 World Book Day Book Token that can either be exchanged for one of ten special £1 World Book Day books or used to get £1 off any book costing £2.99 or more.
